## ★ VOTING IN THE TEXAS PRIMARY ELECTION

A Primary election is a partisan election. Voters decide which candidates move on to the November General Election. **Voters do not have to sign up with a party in advance of the election.** Texas has an open primary system. Voters choose a Republican Party or Democratic Party ballot when they vote in the primary. You may only vote in one party's primary per election. If no candidate receives a majority, a runoff election will be held on May 26. Voting in the Primary Elections is one of the most impactful ways Texans can engage in democracy.

- **Can I vote in the Primary Runoff election if I did not vote in the Primary?**  
YES. *Note:* When you do vote in a party's primary election or convention, you cannot vote in another party's primary or convention.
- **Do I have to vote for the same candidate in November?**  
NO. Vote for any candidate, any party in November.

### YOU MAY PRINT YOUR SAMPLE BALLOT, TAKE NOTES, AND BRING IT WHEN YOU GO TO VOTE.

Texas law doesn't allow voters to use electronic devices (mobile phones, tablets, etc.) while at the polling place. PRINTED OR HANDWRITTEN NOTES are allowed.

## ★ VOTING IN PERSON

- **WHERE? VOTE** at ANY polling place during Early Voting AND on Election Day in Fort Bend county.







## VOTER ID: WHAT TO TAKE TO THE POLLS

You may use one of seven forms of photo ID, listed below.

- Texas Driver License
- Texas Election Identification Certificate
- Texas Personal Identification Card issued by the Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Handgun License issued by DPS
- US Military Identification Card containing your photograph
- US Citizenship Certificate containing your photograph
- US Passport (book or card)

### Note:

- IDs may have expired up to 4 years.
- Persons 70 years or older may use an expired ID, regardless of expiration date.
- ID address does not have to match the voter registration address.
- The name on the photo ID should match the name on the list of registered voters or be “substantially similar”. If your name doesn’t match exactly, you can still vote but will need to sign a form stating you are the person on the list of registered voters.

If you are registered but do not have a photo ID and cannot reasonably obtain one, you may sign a form and present alternative documentation. Learn more at [www.votetexas.gov/voting/need-id.html](http://www.votetexas.gov/voting/need-id.html).

## VOTER HARASSMENT

- Election officials cannot question a voter about the use of an ID type.
- Poll watchers may not: converse with a voter; record in the polling place; or observe a voter voting.

## BE A TEXAS VOTER!

### VOTE BY MAIL

You can vote by mail if you are:

- 65 years or older
  - Sick or disabled
  - Out of the county during early voting and on Election Day
  - Expecting to give birth within 3 weeks before or after Election Day
  - In jail, but otherwise eligible to vote.
- To vote by mail in Texas, you must apply every year! Go to [lwwtexas.org/votebymail](http://lwwtexas.org/votebymail) for a vote-by-mail application and easy-to-understand instructions on voting by mail.
  - Use the online tracker at [VoteTexas.gov](http://VoteTexas.gov): **TRACK MY BALLOT**. If there is an error in your vote-by-mail application or ballot, your county election office is required to notify you and instruct you how to fix it either by mail, in person or via the online tracker.

### VOTE IN PERSON USING CURBSIDE VOTING

- If you are physically unable to enter the polling place without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring your health, you may park at the curbside voting parking space and call the number that is posted to ask that an election officer bring a ballot to your car.
- After you mark your ballot, give it to the election officer or hand it to a companion to deposit in the ballot box for you.




### VOTE EVEN IF YOU ARE A SUSPENDED VOTER

You can still vote if your voter registration is in suspense as long as you are registered in your county! “Suspense” means that your county voter registrar needs to confirm your voting address.

### VOTE A LIMITED BALLOT

If you have moved to a new county and have not registered in that county by the registration deadline, you may be eligible to vote a limited ballot. A limited ballot is one that allows you to vote on candidates and measures that are on the ballot for both your former county and your new county, such as statewide and national races.

• Note: Voting a limited ballot is only available during early voting at your county’s main early voting polling place.
